



Call for participants

For the Training course “Another World is Possible – Understanding Urban Culture and Tools for Conflict Resolution”

July 25th – August 3th, 2017 in Wirksworth, Derbyshire, United Kingdom.

Together with our partners, Baby People are looking for participants from Denmark, Romania, Portugal, Moldova, Ukraine, Armenia, Georgia, and The United Kingdom.

Summary:

“Another World is Possible – Understanding Urban Culture and Tools for Conflict Resolution” is a training course for youth leaders that will take place over 8 working days and bring together 29 youth leaders from The United Kingdom, Denmark, Romania, Portugal, Moldova, Ukraine, Georgia and Armenia.

The Training will be implemented in Wirksworth, Derbyshire, United Kingdom between **July 25th – August 3th**, 2017 (**July 25th** being the day of arrival and **August 3th** being the day of departure).

The aim of the project is to promote urban culture and art as a positive expression of young people’s participation through;

- ensuring youth workers have capacity to reflect upon and respond to the challenges and conflicts faced by young people with fewer opportunities in urban areas
- Promoting European cooperation in the field of youth work, specifically the participation of youth in urban areas;

The training will be based on non-formal learning methods and is designed to encourage reflection and experience sharing. Activities will include simulations and interactive exercises, workshops, presentations and group discussions.

All activities are designed so that participants will have active involvement, and be encouraged to reflect upon their learning.

The sessions will be conducted in English and translation will not be provided. Therefore, the participants are expected to have a good level of English, both written and spoken.

Participants profile:

In order to participate, the candidates should be **above 18 years old** and must fulfill the following requirements:

- Be/or intending to be a youth leader,
- Have a good conduct in English;
- Be able to attend the entire Training course
- Have an interest in Urban Music as a method for inclusion
- Be committed to multiply the results of the project in the local communities.





Candidates who do not fulfill the above requirements will not be considered, and hence be taken off the list.

Application procedure:

For participation in this training, interested candidates are required to complete an on-line application form: <http://intercollege.info/participants/open-calls/application-understanding-urban-culture-and-tools-for-conflict-resolution>

Only complete application forms will be taken into consideration.

The nominated participants should have completed the application form no later than **Monday 12th June, 2017**. Confirmation of the participant selection will be announced by the organizer by Wednesday 14th June, 2017.

Within 5 days after the selection results are announced, participants must prove that they have purchased their tickets with a copy of the invoice and a copy of the e-ticket.

Participant's declaration

Each participant shall read carefully and agree on the Participant Declaration found with the application form. Accepting the Participant Declaration is a requirement of participation.

Travel:

The EU contribution for the travel expenses per participant is as follows:

500-1999km (Denmark & Portugal)	275€
2000 – 2999km (Romania, Moldova, Ukraine)	360€
3000 – 3999km (Georgia, Armenia)	530€

calculated with the [distance calculator](#) of the European Commission. Please check from your home to Wirksworth.

Participants shall be reimbursed for their travel expenses up to the amount available for their countries and no more than their real costs. The amounts have been calculated using the distance calculator of the European Commission from the location of each sending organization to the venue. Should the travel expenses exceed the contribution available, participants shall cover the extra costs from own resources.

Visa

Participants from *Armenia, Georgia, Moldova & Ukraine* must ensure that they arrange visas in good time. A budget of 140€ per participant is available (102€ for visa fee, 20€ for travel to embassy). Participants must cover any costs themselves and present documentation of costs for reimbursement. Participants shall be reimbursed for their travel expenses up to the amount available for their countries and no more than their real costs.





Reimbursement of travel expenses

In order to get reimbursed for their travel expenses, participants shall send the organizer all the originals of travel documentation and invoices. The reimbursements will be made through bank transfers within 45 days after the organizer have received the original documentation by post.

Additionally, the reimbursement will be performed only if the following conditions are met:

1. Participants submit their individual participant report as requested by the European Commission through the Mobility Tool;
2. Participants and their sending organizations send the organizers a proof of dissemination activities.

Insurance:

The participants are responsible to make their own insurance covering them for the whole duration of the training.
