Call for participants

For the Seminar of 'Heritage Hunters', 27th April – 5th May 2018, Nottingham, the United Kingdom.

Together with our partners, we are looking for participants from the UK, Denmark, Armenia, Romania, Turkey, Moldova, Azerbaijan, Ukraine.

Summary

"Heritage Hunters" is a 7-day Seminar to promote cultural heritage among youth through innovative and artistic activities. The Seminar will bring together 28 organisational managers, project managers, youth workers, and other representatives of the partner organisations who have mandate to integrate strategies and policies within their organisation from *the UK, Denmark, Armenia, Romania, Turkey, Moldova, Azerbaijan, Ukraine.*

The Seminar will take place between the **27th April and 5th May 2018**, the 27th April being arrival day and the 5th May being departure day.

The Seminar will offer partners to share practices in cultural heritage education and build upon the results of the study visit in Moldova, with the aim of developing new non-formal education methods and common strategies and policies for the promotion of cultural heritage learning amongst youth.

The objectives of the project are:

- 1) To give youth workers examples of best practice of how to preserve and promote local heritage through artistic activities
- 2) To make youth workers reflect on the importance of cultural heritage in ensuring social capital and participation amongst youth
- 3) To explore youth work practices in combining mainstream and traditional culture through art and entrepreneurship
- 4) To create artistic methods aiming at preserving and promoting cultural heritage among young people, with inputs from practices across 8 partner and programme countries
- 5) To develop concrete strategies and common policies for promoting cultural heritage among young people with inputs from practices across 8 partner and programme countries
- 6) To strengthen and internationalise youth workers and youth organisations professional networks
- 7) To create visibility, dissemination, and local impact through the project for promoting local heritage amongst youth in Europe

The Seminar will be conducted in English and translation will not be provided. Therefore, the participants are expected to have a good level of English, both written and spoken.

Participants profile





In order to participate, the candidates should be at least 18 years old and must fulfil the following requirements:

- Be directly involved in the sending organizations work
- Level of experience & relevance of profile - be a youth worker/youth leader/project manager
- Motivation to disseminate the project results
- Ability to use the results of the project
- Understanding of the wider aim of the project
- Ability to participate during the whole duration of the project
- Interest in and/or knowledge of culture, cultural heritage and artistic expression
- Potential to be positively impacted by the activity
- Ability to communicate in English

Candidates who do not fulfil the above requirements will not be considered, and hence be taken off the list.

Application and selection procedure

Deadlines

The nominated participants should have completed the application form no later than **January 29th**. Confirmation of the participant selection will be announced by the organizer on **January 31st**, the latest. Within 5 days after the selection results are announced, participants must prove that they have purchased their tickets with a copy of the invoice and a copy of the e-ticket.

Travel

The EU contribution for the travel expenses per participant is as follows:

The UK	20€
Denmark	275€
Romania, Ukraine, Turkey, Moldova	360€
Armenia	530€
Azerbaijan	820€

Distances were calculated with the [distance calculator](#) of the European Commission from the location of each sending organization to the venue.

Participants shall be reimbursed for their travel expenses up to the amount available for their countries and no more than their real costs. The amounts have been calculated using the distance calculator of the European Commission from the location of each sending organization to the venue. Should the travel expenses exceed the contribution available, participants shall cover the extra costs from own resources.

Reimbursement of travel expenses





In order to get reimbursed for their travel expenses, participants shall send the organizer all the originals of travel documentation and invoices. The reimbursements will be made through bank transfers within 45 days after the organizer have received the original documentation by post.

Additionally, the reimbursement will be performed only if the following conditions are met:

1. Participants submit their individual participant report as requested by the European Commission through the Mobility Tool;
2. Participants and their sending organizations send the organizers a proof of dissemination activities.

Insurance

The partner organizations must ensure that participants have a travel insurance covering them for the whole duration of the seminar.

Visa

The partner organizations are responsible for ensuring that the selected participants have their visa to travel to the UK, if it is required. The partner organizations must ensure that the visa application procedure is started in good time. Upon request the organizers can provide an invitation letter to help with the visa application.

Program

Attached to this letter is the draft program of the seminar. Please note that some changes in the program could potentially be made. We are happy to receive your suggestions for improvements and your contributions.

Participant's declaration

Each participant shall read carefully and agree on the Participant Declaration found with the application form. Accepting the Participant Declaration is a requirement of participation.
