Call for participants

Together with our partners, we are looking for participants from Slovakia, Azerbaijan, Estonia, the Republic of North Macedonia, Spain, Romania, the Republic of Moldova, Ukraine, Armenia and Denmark for the Training Course “Global Youth”, 13th – 22nd September 2019, Vadul lui Voda, Moldova.

Summary

“Global Youth” is a 10-day Training Course aiming to raise awareness amongst young people upon global challenges to sustainable development, as well as a sense of responsibility and ability to address these challenges and create societies that fosters inclusive and healthy living conditions now and in the future.

The Training Course will bring together 31 participants, including 5 facilitators/trainers from *Slovakia, Azerbaijan, Estonia, the Republic of North Macedonia, Spain, Romania, the Republic of Moldova, Ukraine, Armenia* and Denmark.

The Training Course will take place between the **13th – 22nd September 2019**, the 13th being the arrival day and the 22nd being the departure day.

The objectives of the activity are:

- 1) to introduce partners and participants to global responsibility education;
- 2) to strengthen the capacity of 10 youth organisations within provision of global responsibility education for young people;
- 3) to raise awareness amongst youth workers on global issues and means to address them;
- 4) to promote a sense of responsibility amongst youth workers in challenging human behaviour that is harming to the sustainability of the planet and local societies;
- 5) to foster a sense of innovation and entrepreneurship in creating new initiatives and methods within sustainable development.

The Training Course will be conducted in English and translation will not be provided. Therefore, the participants are expected to have a good level of English, both written and spoken.

Participants profile

In order to participate, the candidates should be in the age of 20 or above and must fulfil the following requirements:

- Be active youth workers within the partner organisations
- Demonstrate motivation to disseminate the project results through his/her daily activities with young people



- Demonstrate ability to use the results of the project
- Understand the wider aim of the project
- Participate during the whole duration of the activity
- Have an interest in and/or knowledge on Global Responsibility (Education)
- Have potential to be positively impacted by the activity
- Have ability to communicate in English.

Candidates who do not fulfil the above requirements will not be considered, and, hence, be taken off the list.

Application and selection procedure

Deadlines

The candidates should have completed the application form no later than **11th of August 2019**. Confirmation of the participant selection will be announced by the organizer on **13th of August 2019** the latest.

Within **5 days** after the selection results are announced, participants must purchase their travel tickets to the activity venue and send the organisers a copy of these.

Participation in the training is free of charge.

Travel

The EU contribution for the travel expenses per participant is as follows:

Republic of Moldova, Romania, Ukraine	180€
Azerbaijan, Slovakia, Estonia, Republic of North Macedonia, Denmark, Armenia	275€
Spain	360€

The travel contribution was calculated using the distance calculator of the European Commission from the location of each sending organization to the venue. Should the travel expenses exceed the contribution available, participants shall cover the extra costs from own resources.

Reimbursement of travel expenses

Participants will be reimbursed for their travel expenses up to the amount available for their countries and no more than their real costs.

In order to get reimbursed for their travel expenses, participants shall send the organizer all the originals of travel documentation and invoices. The reimbursements will be made through bank transfers within 45 days after the organizer have received the original documentation by post.

Additionally, the reimbursement will be performed only if the following conditions are met:

1. Participants submit their individual participant report as requested by the European Commission through the Mobility Tool;
2. Participants and their sending organizations send the organizers a proof of dissemination activities.

Insurance

Participants are responsible to arrange their travel insurance in cooperation with their sending organisations covering them for the whole duration of the training course. The costs for the travel insurance cannot be covered by the project.

Participant's declaration

Each candidate shall read carefully and agree on the Participant Declaration found with the application form. Accepting the Participant Declaration is a requirement of participation.
