Call for participants

Study Visit

For the study visit “Sustainable EntrepreneurShip: Sailing to Success”, 17th November – 25th November 2019, Slettestrand, Denmark.

Together with our partners, we are looking for participants from Romania, Bulgaria, Greece, Italy, Macedonia, Croatia and Denmark.

Summary

“Sustainable EntrepreneurShip: Sailing to Success” is a nine-day study visit hosted by InterCollege, Denmark that aims at improving the skill and competences of youth workers on how to engage young people as sustainable entrepreneurs. The study visit will bring together 30 youth workers and organization managers coming from *Romania, Bulgaria, Greece, Italy, Macedonia, Croatia and Denmark* and will take place between the **17th November** and **25th of November 2019**, the 1th being arrival day and the 25th being departure day.

The objectives of the project, aimed at training youth workers, are enlisted below;

1. Provide youth workers with practical examples of sustainable businesses
2. Enhance the knowledge of youth workers regarding the scope and dimensions of sustainability and sustainable entrepreneurship
3. Strengthen international cooperation and exchange of good practices
4. Encourage youth workers to actively promote sustainable entrepreneurship initiatives by developing an action plan

The study visit will be conducted in English and translation will not be provided. Therefore, the participants are expected to have a good level of English, both written and spoken.

Participants profile

In order to participate, the candidates should be at least 20 years old and **must** fulfil the following criteria:

- Have a relevant profile and experience within youth work
- Availability for the whole duration of the activity
- Demonstrate interest in promoting sustainable entrepreneurship amongst young people
- Ability to communicate effectively in English
- Interest and passion for the theme of the project
- Willingness to actively participate in the activity and to share, promote and disseminate the results of the project

Application and selection procedure

The partner organizations are responsible to nominate participants for the activities. The nominated participants shall complete an application form on the following link:

Participation in the training course is free of charge.

Deadlines

The nominated participants should have completed the application form no later than **September 22nd**. Confirmation of the participant selection will be announced by the organizer on **25th September**.

Within 5 days after the selection results are announced, participants must prove that they have purchased their tickets with a copy of the invoice and a copy of the e-ticket.

Travel

The EU contribution for the travel expenses per participant is as follows for the study visit:

Denmark	20€
Romania, Macedonia, Croatia, Bulgaria, Italy*	275€
Italy**, Greece	360€

Distances were calculated with the [distance calculator](#) of the European Commission from the location of each sending organization to the venue.

**If travelling 500-1999km from home to the venue, in accordance with [distance calculator](#).*

***If travelling over 2000km from home to the venue, in accordance with [distance calculator](#).*

Participants shall be reimbursed for their travel expenses up to the amount available for their countries and no more than their real costs. Should the travel expenses exceed the contribution available, participants shall cover the extra costs from own resources.

Reimbursement of travel expenses

In order to get reimbursed for their travel expenses, participants shall send the organizer all the originals of travel documentation and invoices. The reimbursements will be made through bank transfers within 45 days after the organizer has received the original documentation by post.

Additionally, the reimbursement will be performed only if the following conditions are met:

1. Participants submit their individual participant report as requested by the European Commission through the Mobility Tool;
2. Participants and their sending organizations send the organizers a proof of dissemination activities.

Insurance

The partner organizations must ensure that participants have a travel insurance covering them for the whole duration of the study visit.



Visa

In general, no visa should be required. In exceptional cases, the partner organizations are responsible for ensuring that the selected participants have their visa to travel to Denmark.
