Call for Partners

InterCollege is looking for partner organisations for the project below. The call is open to organisations/institutions located in Programme Countries.

Project background

Free movement of citizens is a fundamental principle enshrined in Article 20 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. According to it, citizens of the European Union have *“the right to move and reside freely within the territory of the Member States”*. Despite the long history of freedom of movement within EU borders, the concept of integration of the mobile citizens is still developing and changing and further efforts are needed to ensure that they have the opportunity and means to be active and engaged within their local communities.

Strategy20 is a 2-year Strategic Partnership, which aim is to strengthen the integration of mobile citizens and to increase the capacity of youth organizations to connect, engage and empower mobile EU citizens. The project will collect examples of local cases, initiatives and policies on the successful integration of mobile citizens across Europe and compile them into a booklet that will be used to further disseminate the projects results.

What is more, local activities will be implemented by each partner, where representatives of the mobile citizens will have the chance to meet with local stakeholders and develop a strategy for connecting, engaging and empowering the former.

Project Activities

1. Kick-off meeting (M1) – introduction to the aim and objectives and defining the frame of the booklet and the format of communicating the examples of best practices
2. Study visit (C1) in Denmark to experience and collect examples of best practices in integrating mobile EU citizens
3. Presentation of best practices (M2) - to consolidate and present the content of the booklet and to plan and discuss the local implementation activities that each partner will conduct in their local community
4. Training course (C2) – training course in Denmark to equip representatives of the partner organisations with knowledge, skills and tools to connect, engage and empower mobile citizens
5. Launching the booklet and planning of local activities (M3)



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6. Local activities: The partners will implement locally two activities:

- A local workshop with mobile citizens in order to gather their challenges and inputs for a better integration in the local society;
- A round table discussion together with local stakeholders and representatives of the mobile citizens in order to develop a local implementation strategy that engages, connects and empowers mobile citizens.

7. Evaluation Meeting (M4)

Project Management Activities and budget use:

With the project management budget, the costs for the followings will be covered:

1. Design and printing of the visibility materials: 2000 euro (administrated by InterCollege)
2. Layout and printing of the booklet: 2000 euro (administrated by InterCollege)
3. Proofreading and editing of the booklet: 2000 euro (administrated by InterCollege)
4. Dissemination of booklet to other youth organisations in Europe: 5000 euro (administrated by InterCollege)
5. Additional budget will be allocated to the Study Visit and the Training Course to enhance the quality of the activities (additional transport costs, expert presentations, etc.)

Project management for partners:

The partners will administrate themselves 3500 euro that shall be used as follows:

1500 euro – base fund for expenses regarding the project administration and implementation

1000 euro – funds to organise and deliver workshops with mobile young people

1000 euro – funds to organise a round table between decision makers and young mobile EU citizens, as well as, develop a local strategy to connect, engage and empower young mobile EU citizens

Eligible Partners:

Associations, NGOs, public or private institutions with a large reach to local and regional youth organisations. The partner shall demonstrate that it has capacity to disseminate the project results amongst a large number of youth organisations at local, regional and national level.
