Call for Participants

Together with our partner organisations, we are looking for participants from Germany, Denmark, Hungary, Lithuania, Slovakia, Czech Republic, North Macedonia, Italy, Romania, Turkey, Estonia, Croatia, Spain, Poland, and Bulgaria for the activity Contact Making Event within the project "InnoBoost - Boosting Value Creation Through Innovation".

*The activity will take place between **24 November – 1 December 2021** in Slettestrand, Denmark.*

Activity Summary

The activity is co-funded through the programme Erasmus+, KA1 - Mobility of Youth Workers and addresses the need of youth workers in leading/managerial positions at the partner organisations to come together to share and foster innovative ideas for transnational youth projects that have potential to yield a high level of long-term impact.

The objectives of the activity are as follows:

- 1) To create a platform for youth workers to test and spar their creative and innovative ideas with peers from other countries
- 2) To encourage creative thinking amongst youth workers and motivation for thinking outside the box.
- 3) To inspire Youth workers with examples of ambitious projects to spark creativity
- 4) To foster cooperation between the youth workers in developing unforeseen and innovative mobility projects

The objectives will be addressed by gathering 40 participants from 18 organisations to work across nationalities and cultures, enhancing creative competence and innovation by broadening their idea process and knowledge within the field of youth work.

The activity will be based around entrepreneurial and innovative thinking in the youth sector. The activity intends to create cooperation between the participating organisations and create unforeseen and innovative projects and actions within the youth sector. Participants will be given space for networking and gain encouragement in entrepreneurial thinking. They will have the opportunity to develop ideas for concrete project proposals in an open environment through interactive sessions, discussions, exercises, group work and presentations. Participants' profile

To participate in the activity, the candidates must fulfil the following requirements:

- Be at least 21 years old;
- Have a management role in the partner organisation;
- Have experience in youth work;
- Have the ability to communicate fluently in English;
- Be available to attend the activity for its entire duration;
- Have agreed to the Participant's Declaration;
- Have agreed to the Green Policy at the venue;
- Have agreed to the Covid-19 safety policy at the venue;

Candidates who do not fulfil the above requirements will not be accepted.

Application and selection procedure

The partner organisations are responsible to nominate participants for the activity. The nominated participants shall complete an application form on the following link: <http://intercollege.info/participants/innoboost> no later than **1 September**. Confirmation of the participants selection will be announced by the organisers on **3 September 2021**.

Within **5 days** after the selection results are announced, participants must confirm their participation in the activity by providing proof that they have purchased their tickets with a copy of the invoice and a copy of the e-ticket.

Travel Budget

The EU contribution for the travel expenses per participant is as follows (per person):

Participants shall be reimbursed for their travel expenses up to the amount available for their countries and no more than their real costs.

Should the travel expenses exceed the contribution available, participants shall cover the extra costs from own resources.

Participation in the activity is free of charge.

Visa

The partner organizations are responsible for ensuring that the selected participants have their visa in case it is required to travel to Denmark. The partner organizations must ensure that the visa application procedure is started in good time. Upon request the organisers can provide an invitation letter to help with the visa application. The available budget for visa is 90€/participant from Turkey.

Please keep all the receipts and documentation regarding the visa application.

Travel Insurance

Participants must have a travel insurance covering them for the whole duration of the activity. It is strongly advised that the travel insurance covers the participants' costs for an eventual Covid-19 treatment and similar expenses.

COVID-19 – Entry Requirements

Denmark classifies regions and countries around the world in four categories: green, yellow, orange and red.
